The indoor sessions will be religious in content with presentations of how the Gospel writers viewed Christ in their writings, and their perception of which type of chalice best represents Christ from their point of view. Biblical knowledge will be needed to answer questions at the outside stations. You will need knowledge, skills, logic and teamwork in your search for the elusive Grail.

Teams will be randomized. Come prepared to participate and have fun!

Indoor sessions will alternate with outdoor skills and tests of your knowledge to determine which Team will find the Holy Grail and present it to the Celebrant at Mass. Will your Team be worthy? Will you then choose wisely?

Check in will be Friday evening. Saturday will begin with the Flag Ceremony and opening Prayer, followed by Breakfast. Then find your Team and begin your journey at the start of the adventure.

Events and sessions will end with time to prepare for Reconciliation, followed by Mass, Dinner and with a living Rosary in the Campfire Ring after sunset.

Sunday will conclude with breakfast, a brief wrap-up, and depart Camp before Noon.

*The Registration Fee for the Retreat is \$20 per Scout or Adult Scouter.
The Fee will include all Saturday meals (3) and Sunday Breakfast, Food, Drinks, Snacks, Plates, Cups, Plastic ware, Supplies for the events, and the Event Patch.*

Class A uniforms is Required for Flag Ceremony, Breakfast, Mass and Dinner. Class B Scout clothing can be worn for the sessions and events.

Please eat before you arrive Friday evening. Bring a water bottle or two. Troops / individuals are responsible for their own tents, cots, pads and sleeping bags. Units will be assigned on a first come basis to the campsites. Please note, Vehicles and trailers do NOT fit in the upper campsites. They will need to be unloaded and moved to the parking lot.

Registration Forms should be Postmarked no later than October 1st to insure processing and adequate food purchases. Late registration will be accepted at Check in. BSA Health Forms and a copy of Health Insurance Cards are required with the Unit or individuals. See the Registration Form NOTES
